



Open Burning – Required Permitting

The burning of materials wherein products of combustion are emitted directly into the ambient air without passing through a stack or chimney from an enclosed chamber. For the purposes of this definition, a chamber shall be regarded as enclosed when, stacks, flues, or chimneys necessary to provide combustion air and permit the escape of exhaust gas are open.

- Open burning that has a pile size greater than 3 feet in diameter and 2 feet in height is required to be a **minimum of 50 feet from a structure. PERMIT REQUIRED**
- Open burning in an approved (non-combustible) container is required to be a **minimum of 15 feet from a structure. PERMIT REQUIRED**



- Open burning having a pile size less than 3 feet in diameter and 2 feet in height is required to be a **minimum of 25 feet from a structure. NO PERMIT REQUIRED**
- Agricultural burning. **PERMIT REQUIRED**
